



SEASONAL MEMBERSHIP POLICY

Effective 01/2018

Springwood Swim Club is a non-profit corporation fully supported by its members. All contributions, fees, and other income etc. will be used to own and operate the club. We offer bond and seasonal memberships.

Becoming a Member

- a. Upon receipt of your seasonal membership dues in full you are a member of the Springwood Club and are to be afforded access to all of the club's facilities and events.

II. Membership

- a. A membership is awarded to the "family unit" or "household" that consists of a maximum of two adults plus children living at the same residence under the age of 26 years. Additional adults must be registered as "Associate Members."
- b. Seasonal membership are also available and priced for:
 1. 2 Adults or 1 Adult/1 Child
 2. 1 Adult
 3. Senior Citizen Rates are Available

III. Yearly Dues

- a. Payment of the annual dues is due for prior to opening day.
- b. Payment plans are available and must be pre-approved by the Executive Officers of the Board.

I. Membership Referral Program

- a. Current members who refer a NEW member will receive 10 FREE guest passes. Anyone who brings in two or more members will receive an entry for each new member into a drawing for a FREE Springwood Swim Club Membership for the following season.



- b. Former members are not eligible to qualify as a new member.
- c. Winner to be selected at drawing held on Labor Day.

II. Withdrawal

- a. It has been the long-standing policy of the Board of Governors that there is no refund available for the current year's dues.

III. Suspension or Expulsion

- a. Any member of the Club may, for cause and after having been given an opportunity for a hearing, be suspended for a period exceeding 7 days but not exceeding three months by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members of the Board of Governors present at any meeting thereof, or expelled by a three-fourths (3/4) vote of the entire Board of Governors.

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- b. Cause for suspension or expulsion shall, in general, consist of violation of the Clubs By-Laws or of the rules of the Club, or of conduct unbecoming a member, or to the prejudice of the good order of the Club.
- c. The Board of Governors may delegate to the pool management, or to a responsible employee of the Club, the power to suspend Club privileges for the violation of Club Rules and Regulations, provided such suspension does not exceed seven (7) days. A written report of such suspension, containing reasons therefore, shall be submitted to the President within twenty-four (24) hours.

IV. Non-Transferable

Membership is an agreement between the member and the pool club. It cannot be transferred to another person.
